

Swimming Pool Committee Charge
Board of Education Meeting
April 26, 2011

It is the responsibility of the Pocantico Hills Board of Education to develop and implement policies, rules and regulations governing the use of school facilities.

The Board of Education at its discretion may select community representatives to provide the Board with advice and reaction about important matters before the Board which may have a special significance for the community.

The Board of Education has decided to seek input from community members regarding the development of policies, rules, and regulations governing the use of the District's swimming pool.

The Swimming Pool Committee shall be Co-Chaired by the Pool Director and the Assistant Superintendent for Finance and Support. Ideally the Swimming Pool Committee shall be comprised of five to seven members including a member of the Board of Education, the Camp Director and one member from each the following neighborhoods; Briggsville, Lake Association, The Hamlet, Westchester Hills Condominiums, Knollwood, and Pocantico Park.. Committee membership shall be selected by the Superintendent of Schools or her designee. Committee members shall be selected based upon their representation of the neighborhoods listed above, their experiences related to the Pocantico Hills swimming pool, and upon their submitted letters of interest to serve on this Committee.

The Committee's recommendations will be made to the Board no later than May 24, 2011. The recommendations will include but not be limited to the following topics:

1. Pool Rules, security procedures, regulations or polices for use by residents and non residents
2. Use of Locker Rooms
3. Pool Open and Close Times
4. Dates of operations
5. Community use of pools including senior swim, community swim, day camp
6. Fee structure for guests of residents
7. Fee structure for non residents
8. Fee structure for residents
9. Swim meets
10. Membership and implementation of swim team
