Dear Community Members:

On January 20, 2010 the Board of Education created a Citizens/Teacher/CSEA Advisory Committee to assist the Board with the search for a new Superintendent of Schools. The Committee will be comprised of thirteen community and staff members, and two members of the Board of Education. The membership is to be comprised as follows:

- A. Two parents that do not currently have children in the Pocantico Hills School
- B. Two parents with grade school age children
- C. Two parents with middle school age children
- D. Two parents with children attending one of the District's three partner high schools
- E. Four members of the Pocantico Hills Teaching Association (PHTA)
- F. One member of the Civil Service Employees Association (CSEA)

The Committee will be chaired by Dr. Robert Monson, District Superintendent of the Southern Westchester BOCES. Dr. Monson has been appointed by the Pocantico Hills Board of Education to lead the search for a new Superintendent.

The Board of Education approved the Charge for this Committee on February 8, 2010, and it is attached for your review. If you are interested in assisting the Board of Education by serving on this Committee please send a letter of interest stating why you make a good committee member. Please send the letter to the District Clerk, Mrs. Gina Downes, no later than 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, February 25, 2010. If you are a parent with children in multiple grades please include this information in your letter so that the Board of Education may consider you as a representative for other grade levels. If you have previously submitted a letter of interest to the Board of Education you must re-submit your letter to the District Clerk.
