

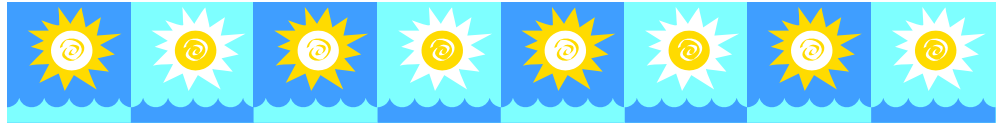

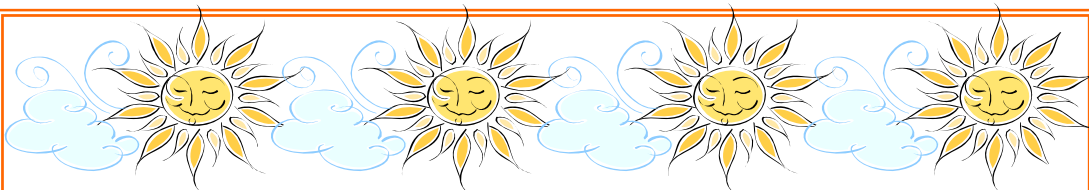

The following is a list of supplies you will need to send to class as well as information you will need to know for the upcoming school year. All supplies should be in school by **Monday, September 13, 2010.**

## Supplies:

- One (1) Standard size backpack with zippers (not drawstrings, no wheels please)
- One (1) Plastic lunchbox
- One (1) Small Plastic Supply Box
- Two (2) Plastic pocket folders (1 green and 1 orange)
- One (1) 1 ½" Green Vinyl 3 Ring Binder
- Four (4) Jumbo Glue Sticks (preferably Elmer's)
- Three (3) Boxes of 24 Count Crayola crayons
- One (1) Pair of Fiskar Blunt Scissors
- One (1) Standard size coloring book for rainy day recess
- One (1) Standard size drawing pad (blank white pages)
- Two (2) Boxes (12 each) of No. 2 Ticonderoga pencils
- Two (2) Boxes of facial tissues
- One (1) Purell Hand Sanitizer

Two (2) Tubs of Wet Ones Antibacterial Hand Wipes

## Important Information:

- Please **label** everything (especially all coats, hats, sweaters, etc.).
